

This guide provides basic instructions to set up Turnitin Assignments in Canvas. It includes two sections:

- How to create a Turnitin Assignment inside your Canvas website
- How to fix syncing issues between Canvas and Turnitin

The guide assumes you have a basic knowledge of Canvas. Before you start we recommend that you:

- Read the <u>Design and build your Canvas site</u> information in our Teaching Resources Hub
- Attend a <u>Canvas Skills workshop</u>

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CREATING A TURNITIN ASSIGNMENT IN CANVAS								
In Canvas, the Turnitin assignment is generated inside a Canvas assignment. Follow these steps to create a Turnitin assignment.

 5. In the 'Assign' box, enter your assignment 'Due' Date and 'Available from' Date. Note: Leave the 'Until' date field empty to avoid potential issues with late submissions (see section Addressing syncing issues between Canvas and Turnitin, 'Dealing with late submissions').  6. Click to 'Save' or 'Save & Publish'. Note: 'Save & Publish' will make the assignment available to both staff and students. You cannot mark the assignment if it is unpublished. The published or unpublished status can be changed on the Assignments page by clicking on the green tick or the red no circle to the right of the assignment's name. HOW TO FIX SYNCING ISSUES BETWEEN CANVAS AND TURNITIN

K	KNOWN ISSUES							
Th To	There have been reports of synchronisation problems between Canvas and Turnitin. To avoid potential loss of work or other errors, it is important to follow the steps below.							
1.	Completed marking is disappearing, getting lost or not showing up	Issue: If Turnitin rubrics are changed or removed from an assignment, rubric scores will be lost and cannot be retrieved by Educational Innovation, Turnitin or Canvas.						
		Solution : Assign a single person to control all Turnitin settings – make this person responsible for setup and making all changes to the settings of each Turnitin assignment.						
2.	Turnitin GradeMark and Canvas Marks not syncing	Issue: Marks flow from Turnitin to Canvas, but not in reverse. If a mark is changed in Canvas Marks, the change will not be updated in Turnitin and a student will see different marks in Canvas and Turnitin.						
		This is typically fixed by removing the grade in the Turnitin Feedback Studio tool, hitting enter or clicking away from the entry box (to push the 'no mark' through), then re-entering the mark.
