A note about generative artificial intelligence

For this assignment, we are open to you using generative text-to-text AI tools (such as ChatGPT, Bing Chat, Elicit.org, Research Rabbit, etc) to support your learning, if you wish to use such tools. The use of these tools must be within the following parameters:

- You are permitted to use the tools to help you:
 - brainstorm ideas (which <u>seems to be one of the main ways</u>
 ⇒that researchers use ChatGPT), or
 - summarise current knowledge about a topic, or
 - discover literature to read and use.
- If you use these tools, you must include a short footnote explaining what you used the tool for, and the prompts that you used (if applicable). Such a footnote is not included in the word count.
- Don't post confidential, private, personal, or otherwise sensitive information into these tools. Their privacy policies can be a bit murky.
- Your assessment submission must not be taken directly from the output of these tools.
- If you use these tools, you must be aware of their limitations, biases, and propensity for fabrication.
- Ultimately, you are 100% responsible for your assessment submission.

Using these tools is **not** required; you are of course most welcome to complete this assignment without the aid of these tools.
